From the "Rules of Procedure" of the Classis of the Heartland:

D. Interim Committee:

2. Classical Appointments:

- a. The CIC shall offer classical appointments to churches without a pastor. The church shall pay the sending church \$100.00 per service and pay the pastor the classical mileage rate which is the same as that established by the IRS.

There should be two checks: 1 - to the church - \$100.00 per service

2 – to the pastor – mileage at IRS rate

- c. Assignments are to be made with the following guidelines:

1.) Ordinarily every second Sunday, except when there are four or more vacancies, then once a month. *(Note: Assignments have been recently made once a month, ordinarily on the second Sunday of the month. Exceptions are made upon request or for Easter and Christmas.)*

2.) There will be no classical appointments for the months of June, July, and August unless no seminarians are available.

3.) Classical appointments will not be made until at least two months after the CIC has been notified by a church of their desire to have classical appointments.

4.) All parties ordinarily shall be notified two months in advance.

*Noting the changing geography of our classis the following adjustments have been made to the practice of pulpit supply:

A. Pastors providing pulpit supply will not be assigned to cross the line separating Sergeant Bluff and the churches to the north from Omaha and the churches to the south more than one time per year.

B. Churches for whom paying mileage for pastors crossing this line is a hardship may request 50% reimbursement of that mileage from the classical treasurer.
